End-of-Course Examination Program (EOCEP) Algebra 1, Biology 1, English 2 and United States History and the Constitution

During Spring 2024, an English 2 standalone field test, consisting of one writing essay question, will be administered online only. To assist districts in scheduling the English 2 standalone field test, the state testing window will open one-week early and districts may add up to ten days onto the beginning of their district testing windows. The extra days may only be used for the standalone English 2 writing field test. They may not be used for any other EOCEP tests.

Each District Test Coordinator (DTC) is responsible for identifying the district—level testing window and for notifying the School Test Coordinator (STC) of the testing schedule. DTCs and STCs are responsible for ensuring that the testing schedule is posted on the school's website at least one month prior to the opening of the state testing window. All scheduled testing, including make-up tests, must be administered within the district's testing-window.

For Algebra 1, Biology 1, English 2–Reading, and USHC, the district testing window **must not begin earlier than the last 15 instructional days of the semester or school year**. EOCEP testing must be scheduled to begin early in the district testing window and must include dates for make—up testing that are within the district window.

For the operational English 2 Writing section, the district testing window must not begin earlier than the last 20 instructional days of the semester or school year. English Reading and Writing sections must not be administered on the same day.

For all tests, the district testing window may be scheduled to extend beyond the end of the semester or school year.

In addition, the districts must administer the career readiness assessments to those seniors who wish to retake one or more parts of the Career Readiness Assessment to improve their scores and/or credentials. However, seniors may retake the assessment only two times in the 12 grade— once during the fall administration and once during the spring administration. Students may not retake any part of the Career Readiness Assessment during the same test window. If a student has more than one test attempt or test score for fall or spring, the Office of Assessment and Standards will delete any unauthorized attempt/score.
